## BFO WISH LIST

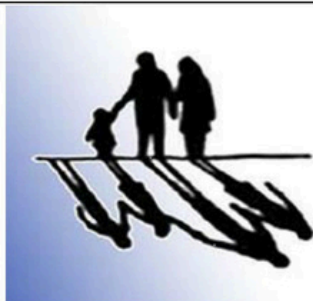

# A Retreat for Healing Hearts

This retreat was a soul-soothing balm for a bereaved mama's heart. From the very first moment, Susan and Joyce welcomed us with a warmth that only those who've walked through the fire of grief can offer.

We gathered to light candles for our children, small flames flickering in the dim light, each one a quiet tribute to lives that were too brief but unforgettable. It was a simple act, yet profoundly moving, a way to invite their unique spirits, usually carried in our hearts, into a room filled with love.

Hosted at the Villa St. Joseph Ecology and Spirituality Centre, owned and staffed by the Sisters of the Congregation of the Sisters of St. Joseph in Canada, the setting was nothing short of breathtaking. With sunsets painting the sky in hues of pink and orange, it felt as though the universe itself was offering us a comforting hug.

The food was another highlight, a comforting reminder that sometimes, the little things can be a big part of healing. Each meal was lovingly prepared, rich in flavor and care. Around the table, laughter filled the air as old friendships were rekindled and new ones blossomed.

We witnessed our children's mischievous spirits as they played with the fire, reminding us to "stop, drop, and roll." As we shared memories of how their short lives touched the people and communities around them, we were reminded of the lessons they taught us: to be determined, to include everyone, to cherish the medicine of music, to embrace sword fighting, to experience the love of a grandchild, to let our wild hearts "bling out," and to find fun wherever we could—whether in pranks, spatula hockey, or spontaneous moments. These Kodak moments will forever stay with us.

Our final moments together were set to the melody of One Love. For a brief moment, the heaviness in our hearts lifted. We danced, held one another, and smiled, not because the grief was gone, but because in that moment, we allowed ourselves to feel joy again. It was as if the universe was reminding us that love, hope, and life are still there to be embraced.

This retreat was a beautiful, messy, joyful, and deeply emotional experience. It gave us the space to honor our children, to connect with one another, and to embrace the fullness of life, even as we carry the weight of loss.

A truly healing experience, one that we will each carry in our hearts, just as we carry and honour the memory of our awesome children.

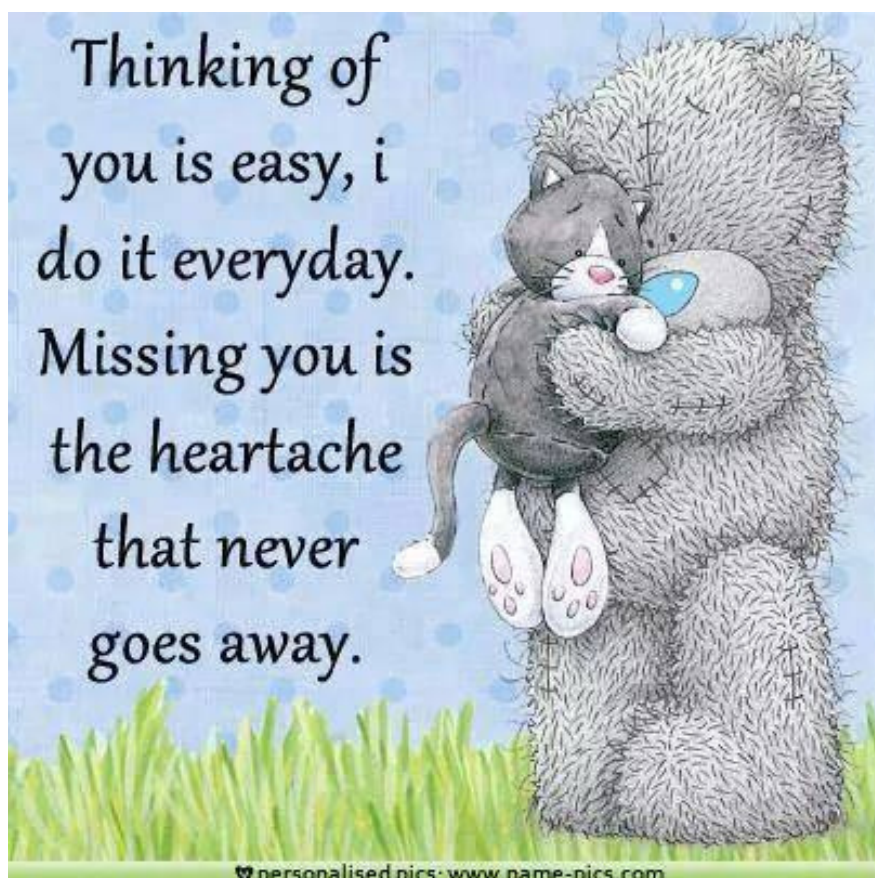
